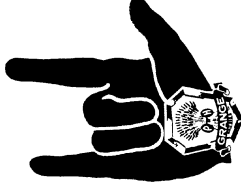
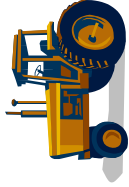
◆ A non-profit organization whose roots are in agriculture.
