

Annual Food Bank Drive

Through your Subordinate/Community and Pomona Grange, you can collect non-perishable food throughout the year. Items such as flour, sugar, cake mixes or other type of mixes in boxes should not be collected, as they can become contaminated by insects and/or spoil before they are used. Donations can be sent with your delegates to the State Session in June.

For the 2011 collection **only** at the state session in Corvallis, we will have a "**Beavers vs. Ducks**" theme. Granges can choose which team they support and donate the food accordingly. Special prizes will be given to the Grange (either Duck supporter or Beaver supporter), who collects the most.

- All food donations and monies collected will be delivered to the food bank in the hosting counties during the state session.
- Donations can also be made to your local food bank, and you will receive credit on your semi-annual report.
- Every Subordinate/Community and Pomona Grange that participates in food bank drives will receive a certificate of participation.
