

Super JG Award

A special award pin will be presented to each Junior Grange member who meets the following requirements:

- Repeat the Junior Grange Pledge to a qualified person.
- Demonstrate the following to a qualified person: Junior grip; Salutation accompanied by the correct language; voting sign; and use of the gavel.
- Draw the floor plan of the Grange meeting room, including the proper placement of the Altar, flag, cloth and all officer stations.
- Explain the procedures used in opening and closing the Grange: opening the Bible, flag presentation and retiring, and retiring the emblem.
- Explain the procedure for presenting a motion.
- Create a Lecturer's program and present it at a meeting or special event. The program should be about ten minutes long. Attach a copy to the national application.
- Enter at least two state sponsored Junior Grange contests within the past year or secure a new Junior Grange member.
- Score at least 85% on the Super JG written quiz on Grange history, Junior Manual and general knowledge of Junior Grange programs. The quiz is developed by the National Grange and is available from the State Grange Junior Director.

These activities will be worked upon during the state session.
