

## Bowling

(Oregon Program)

The State Grange Youth Committee sponsors a bowling tournament open to Junior Grange members, Subordinate/Community Grange members and non-members. The purpose of the tournament is to promote fellowship while having a good time.

### Teams

- Four-member team
- Two-member team
- An individual bowler may not be on more than one team. Each team must consist of at least 50% Grange members. Junior members will compete separately in a Junior category. Junior age family and friends are eligible to compete if their parents or grandparents are Grange members.
- Each team that enters must register with the State Youth Director by **May 15** to make sure we can reserve space at the bowling alley. No registration fee is required but we cannot guarantee a space to bowl without your registration information. Each team is responsible for paying its own shoe rental and bowling fees at the time of the event.

### Rules

- Team members must be from the same Pomona and consist of at least one Grange member for the two-member team and two Grange members for the four-member team.
- Handicaps will be used and figured the day of the contest.
- The state contest will consist of three games and the team with the most total pins will be declared the winner.
- Bumpers may be used up to age 7.
- The first place teams, high game (M,W,Jr), and high series (M,W,Jr) at the state tournament will be awarded a certificate

and each participant will also receive a certificate.

- The state tournament will usually take place on Sunday of the state Grange session.
