

Oregon State Grange Youth Officer

(Oregon Program)

- Applicants for state youth officer must be youth age, 14 to 34 years on January 1st of the year session is held, and must submit their application by **April 15** to the State Youth Director. The application is online at www.orgrange.org/youth.htm. The State Youth Committee will select State Youth Officers and the State Youth Director is responsible for informing the applicants of their office.
- Youth Officers cannot hold the same office for two consecutive years.
- All officers will need to attend State Session Monday through Thursday.
- Officers with speaking parts will have their parts thoroughly memorized upon arrival at state session. The AS is responsible for having an entrance drill prepared. The LAS is responsible for having an exit drill prepared.
- Dress requirements for Youth Officers on Thursday morning when opening State Session:
 - Male officers will be required to wear a button-up shirt, slacks, tie, jacket and street shoes (no athletic shoes).
 - Female officers will be required to wear a floor length dress. There is a Youth clothes closet available if assistance is needed in acquiring an appropriate dress.
- Youth officers will have other duties during the week of annual session, such as working with the juniors, assisting in the concession stand, selling raffle tickets, helping deputies and a number of other tasks which may require youth assistance during the week.
- State Youth Officers will also be available, as their interests permit, to assist local Junior and Subordinate/Community
