

Oregon State Grange Session

Youth play a major role in making the annual June session of the Oregon State Grange successful. Many activities are planned for the benefit of the young adults in attendance. These include the annual banquet, tours, Youth Night, and various contests outlined in the Youth Handbook and the Thursday opening of the state session by the State Youth Officers.

- Applicants for state youth officers should be ages 14-35 and must submit their application by **April 1** to the State Youth Co-Directors. The State Youth Committee will select the State Youth Officers and inform the applicants of their office.
- All officers will need to attend the state session Monday through Thursday. Officers will need to have their parts memorized upon arrival at state session.
- At opening, male officers will be required to wear a button-up shirt, slacks, tie, jacket and nice shoes, and female officers will be required to wear a floor-length dress. If you do not have the appropriate apparel, please let a member of the State Youth Committee know and they can find you something in the Youth Closet.
- Youth officers will also be working with the Juniors, helping in the concession stand, selling raffle tickets, helping as a deputy and a number of other tasks during the session.
- They will also be available to assist their local Junior and Subordinate/Community Granges throughout the year.
- It is, however important to note that an applicant may not hold the same office for two consecutive years.
